Interest ~~for one year was \$32.08 and we~~ ~~paid~~ income was 16.89 which leaves a balance of \$24.45.

Stony made a motion to increase the mowing fee to \$30.00 a year. Seconded by Rhoda & passed.

Rhoda made a motion that Elsie be elected Sec-Treas for next three years. Emma seconded & motion passed.

Emma extended invitation for next year. Stony made motion to adjourn - Rhoda seconded

The Treas report showed a balance of \$24.45 plus interest of \$16.89 (May 74), 18.43 (Nov. 74) & 18.43 (May 75) a donation of \$5⁰⁰ by Anna Swanson & bank charge of \$1.00 ^{and check of \$30 to Spurling} which leaves a balance of \$52.20. It was agreed to offer \$30 to Dennis Spurling for mowing which then leaves \$22.20. It was noted that interest on the Time Certificate is now 6% & it was decided to buy a 4 year Time Cert. at 7 1/4% in November when the current certificate matures. Rhoda made this motion & Emma seconded the motion.

Dear

At the North Logan Cemetery meeting on April 9, 1987, a concern was raised and a motion passed regarding funding of perpetual care of the cemetery.

For the past several years, spring and summer cleanups, mowing, and general maintenance has been provided by the few families that still live in this immediate area. This has been done so that we don't have to spend money from the cemetery savings account. We currently have \$1,484.70 in the savings account and Certificate of Deposit. We feel that we need to maintain a minimum balance of \$3,000, which should average \$150 in yearly interest. It is our hope that you will help us meet this goal so that we can all be assured that the North Logan Cemetery will be taken care of in the future, by using the interest only.

Many of you do not live in this area and we know that our children and grandchildren may possibly relocate in other states as well, which leads to our concern about who will take care of the cemetery in 15-20 years. Some of you have purchased plots at North Logan Cemetery and others just have relatives already buried there (parents, grandparents, great-grandparents, etc.).

We have kept with what we believed was the original concept of offering plots to the Sonderup family at a very minimal cost, but we now feel that this policy may have to change. We are still planning to sell plots (4 spaces) for \$25 to family (and extended family) this year, so if you are interested, please contact us soon. We are then thinking of opening it up to the general public for \$100-\$150 per plot. Enclosed you will find a map of the cemetery.

Some of the ways of generating more principal in the cemetery account were discussed:

- (a) charge more money for plots
- (b) appeal to relatives and plot owners for donations
- (c) include North Logan Cemetery in our wills
- (d) specify memorials from funerals to North Logan Cemetery
- (e) offer plots for sale to the general public

Please help us with a one-time donation, yearly donations until we reach our goal, will and memorial considerations, or any ideas you may think of.

In the past few years old trees that had died were taken out and have been replaced with many Colorado Blue Spruce trees. These were planted along the north and west sides of the cemetery. A new gate was built and installed and other general beautification projects have been undertaken.

Deeds were sent to those that owned a plot. Also included were maps of the cemetery. Donations were received from 13 families for a total of \$235.00. Letters were sent out in April 1988 to these people thanking them, by the secretary.

Bete suggested that we plant (plug in) Buffalo grass & let it choke out the other grass. This type of grass would not have to be mowed as often.

Dan discussed the possibility of getting a mower from John Deere. The cemetery would have to ask for a bid, there would be no sales tax & we would get a 15% discount. More discussion was held on this.

Also discussed was the purchase of 4 plots by Dennis Hansen. He had indicated he & his family would be purchasing plots 44, 45, 52 & 53 & possibly be putting up a memorial for their mother Lois Hansen. Money was never rec'd for this so the Sec-Treas. will write to him to see if they are still interested, they would be \$25 per plot.

Elsie made a motion to nominate Mel for trustee, Rhoda nominated Virgil. Nom. were closed. Virgil was elected.

Mowing will be done May 21st. May 30th is Memorial Day.
