Minutes of the last meeting were read & approved. The Treasurer's report indicated that \$260.00 was received since the last meeting, 1-7-90, \$75.00 for purchase of plots, & \$185.00 in donations & memorials. As of May 14, 1991 we have a balance of \$2,879.65.

A motion was made and carried after discussion, that the North Logan Cemetary Association reserves the right to mow at their discession, that old flowers will not be preserved if those mowing feel they should be discarded.

In order to keep plot owners & donors informed about the cemetary, a motion was made & approved that the Secretary send out a brief summary of the minutes from the meeting.

A motion was made & approved to re-imburse for mowing, or for supplies, if a bill in turned into the Treasurer.

A motion was made & approved to pay Dan & Ray \$50.00 each for mowing last year.

Also discussed were markers of the plots. Dan volunteered to look into this. Perpetual care was also discussed.

Election was held for Trustee. Virgil was re-elected for another 3 year term. Election for Secretary-Treasurer will be in 1992, which Cindy is currently serving. Marlys Sems is the President, with election for this office to be in 1993.

Mowing & general clean-up of the cemetary will be done on Saturday afternoon, May 18th. Everyone is urged to help if they can.

Donations and plot purchases may be made to the Secretary-Treasurer anytime.

Cindy extended an invitation for next year's meeting. Meeting adjourned.

The meeting was called to order by Marlys Sems, President.

Minutes were ready by the Secretary of the March 24, 1991 meeting and approved.

Treasurer's report, balance of \$1,408.37 in the savings account and \$2,267.13 in CD on 12/31/93. Treasurer's report was accepted.

Old Business:

Discussion was held on the care of the cemetery. Ideas were: spray for clover, possibly a lawn service to do this, or the Howard Co. Weed Control in St. Paul. Longterm care was also discussed. Ideas for this were asking the Wolbach cemetery take it over, hire a lawn service under contract to spray and mow every year, through Wolbach or Grand Island. It was decided we need someone with the equipment, time and know how.

Ray volunteered to contact Sonny Nealon of Wolbach to see if the Wolbach cemetery would want to take over. Motion was made and seconded to contact Wolbach and St. Paul to see if either is interested in taking care of the cemetery with perpetual care. If not, then contact a lawn service to see if they will mow. Guidelines would be before Memorial Day, and then every 3-4 weeks during the summer after that. A decision will be made at the April meeting. Motion passed. It was agreed, however that we should spray for clover and do the general cleanup in May this year.

New Business:



Discussion was held on trimming or removing the large trees above the graves. Elsie said that the trees above and around the Rasmussen graves would be in the way when trying to dig a grave there. Minutes of the March 6, 1994 meeting were read & approved. Treasurer's report showed \$1,563.96 in savings as of 4/20/94 and \$2,267.13 in CD as of 12/31/94, total \$3,831.09. Treasurer's report was accepted.

Ray reported that he was not able to inquire about the Wolbach Cemetery taking over as Sonny Nealon was gone when he stopped. It was suggested to contact Stan Edwards at Citizen's Bank in St. Paul about the Viola Sonderup estate to see if they would take care of the cemetery. Also, Jim Horky in St. Paul will be contacted to find out about the St. Paul Cemetery. We will need to contract every year to have someone mow the cemetery unless we can consolidate with another cemetery. Marlys said she would draft a letter to the St. Paul cemetery to see if they would be interested in taking over, and what they would require.

Discussion was held on the cost of mowing and spraying of clover (after May 31). It was decided that if it was too expensive we could send out a letter to ask for donations.

Motion was made by Marlys not to spend any more than \$500.00 this summer. It was seconded by Rhoda and motion carried.

Old Business:

The trees have not been cut down yet. Sylvia knows a man that will do it for \$75.00. He will be notified. Discussion was held on the highway marker in the s.e. corner. It was suggested that we put a steel post beside it so it doesn't get hit with a mower.

Reminder of mowing day, May 21st, 28th rain day.

The North Logan Cemetery Association held their annual meeting on May 25, 1995 at the home of Mel & Marlys Sems. Present were: Ray & Rhoda Christensen, Virgil & Elsie Stonestreet, Dan & Rosanne Christensen, Alton & Sylvia Schmitt, Pete & Cindy Luth, and Mel & Marlys Sems.

The meeting was called to order by President Marlys Sems. The Minutes from the April 24, 1994 meeting were read and approved. Treasurers report was given showing a balance of \$2,397.20 in the CD and \$1,490.48 in the Savings account, total \$3,887.68. Accepted.

Discussion was held on adding money to the CD from the savings account. Marlys made the suggestion to put \$500.00 more into the CD when it comes due. Cindy will check into whether or not we could take money out (if we needed it), without being penalized. It will be decided when the time comes. Motion was made and accepted.

It was decided to spray round-up around the fences. Dan said he would buy some and apply it. Some money was contributed from those present to help pay for it. Ray reported that Plant Island sprayed for clover in Aug. 1994, with the cost of \$50.00. It was applied again this spring at no charge. Mowing was done May 20, 1995. Ray spoke to Carl Nielson & he indicated he would be willing to mow after Memorial Day & let us know what he will charge. There are still a few holes that need to be filled in & also some graves are sinking. The gate needs painting. A steel rod was put by the highway marker.

Marlin Richardson was contacted by Sylvia & Alton and they removed the trees that were discussed at last year's meeting. Mr. Richardson was paid \$75.00 in August, 1994.

Marlys reported that she contacted the St. Paul Cemetery and received a reply that they would not be able to take the Cemetery over. They referred us to the Howard County Commissioner's office. Two letters were sent to them. Also a letter and Grant Application were sent to the Fred J. & Nora H. Sonderup Trust Board, Citizens Bank & Trust Co, St. Paul, NE and we have not received a reply back yet.

Discussion was held again on having a sign made to be put up in the Cemetery that says "North Logan Cemetery." Sylvia volunteered to get estimates on this and try to raise the money to pay for it by notifying relatives of this project. If enough money is raised, the sign will be made and installed. Motion was made by Sylvia, seconded by Marlys and the motion passed.

Election for Sect./Treasurer for the '95-'98 term was held. Marlys nominated Cindy, and Pete seconded. Cindy was elected for another term.

Sylvia and Alton extended an invitation for next years meeting at their home in Kearney.

The meeting was called to order by Cindy Luth, Sec./Treas. for Marlys Sems, President who could not attend. The minutes were read and approved from the May 25, 1995 meeting. The treasurers report was submitted and approved showing a balance of \$2473.96 in the CD as of 12/14/95 and \$1716.23 in the savings account as of 3/19/96, total of \$4,190.19. Treasurers and secretary reports were passed out to those in attendance. A check was received today from Elsie Stonestreet in the amount of \$320.00 which was memorials from Emma Rasmussen, who's burial was on Oct. 9, 1995.

Sign -- Sylvia reported that a donation was received from someone in every Sonderup family for the new sign. There has been some extra given and will be in the account if something needs to be done. She was thanked for taking on and completing this project. The sign looks very nice.

Perpetual care -- Sylvia also reported on the progress of this project. She said we should be hearing back from an attorney regarding the Howard County Commissioner's and perpetual care of the cemetery soon. The state allows the county \$350.00 per year for perpetual care of county cemeteries. Sylvia said the attorney was going to request a hearing. Elsie made a recommendation to have the attorney represent us in court if we need him to at the County Commissioner's hearing. Discussion was held on holding a raffle to raise money for the fund, if the above fails. Sylvia & Elsie volunteered to head this project.

Discussion was also held regarding the Sonderup Trust Fund. (we haven't rec'd any money from) It was decided that this should be resubmitted & add more info. (cover letter) & mention the Sonderup relation again in the letter for the trust fund. It is done annually.

Mowing -- Ray reported that Carl Nielson declined to mow as he had previously said he would in 1995. It was decided to run an ad in the area papers for someone to mow. A suggested charge was \$50.00 each time, or ask what they would charge. (It was decided in 1994 not to spend more than \$500.00 that summer on lawn service) If we couldn't get anyone to mow for money, perhaps we could group names together of relatives and those families would be responsible for mowing for a month at a time each. Cindy will be responsible to run an ad or get someone to mow. Date set for general mowing is May 11th at 1:00. Rain date the 25th.

New CD -- if Treasurer felt there would be enough money in savings account to cover mowing expenses this summer, we would put \$1500 in a new CD.

Election for President - Motion was made by Pete & seconded by Sylvia to re-elect Marlys. Marlys was elected. Cindy will check with her to see if she'll accept. Election for Trustee will be in 1997.

NORTH LOGAN CEMETERY ASSOCIATION held another meeting in Nov. 1997 at the home of Pete & Cindy Luth. Due to bad roads and weather most people were unable to attend.

Cindy got a \$1000.00 CD on 6/16/97.

Alton made a motion to accept the minutes from the May 1997 meeting. Passed.

Sylvia reported that Marvin sent an application and she filled it out & sent to the Citizens Bank & Trust in St. Paul for the Fred J. & Nora H. Sonderup Trust Fund. Voting will be this month on his. We will re-apply every year.

Discussion was held on what it would take to set up a Trust Fund. The following is from a letter Sylvia received back from David L. Scheer, President of the Citizens Bank & Trust Co. in St. Paul: Dear Sylvia, As we discussed on the telephone, it is very difficult to predict what it will take in terms of a fund to preserve the cemetery forever. The current costs with consideration for future inflation and increases would be the most practical approach to take, but that does not guarantee that the fund will be there forever. As we had discussed, the current costs for mowing, spraying and general grounds maintenance plus costs for management and accounting of the fund would require approximately \$15,000.00 with today's rate of return. If the fund is going to earn enough to grow and increase the earning power for future increases in costs, then the fund should probably be more like \$20,000.00 or \$25,000.00. This should provide a fund large enough to withstand the inflation issues and any unforeseen problems without touching the principal of the fund. The group will want to address issues now that may need directive later. These issues may be, who will oversee this fund, what types of investments would the group like to see used, what should be done with the fund if there is no longer a need for it, should the principal of the fund ever be touched for preservation of the cemetery, and other items that may effect the future of the cemetery and/or the board of trustees. I have just touched on a few of the items that we had discussed or that may be of concern. There are more issues that I am sure you and your group will have. I hope that this helps and if I can be of any further assistance, please give me a call.

More discussion was held on this subject. We cannot plan anything at this time as we do not know if and how much money we will receive from the Sonderup Trust Fund. (Note: we did receive \$500.00 in Dec. 1997)

Meeting was adjourned.


It would be appreciated if everyone would pick up flowers within 2 weeks after Memorial Day unless they are part of the headstone.

Election for Trustee for the 2006-2009 term was held. Rhoda nominated Lloyd. Mary seconded. Lloyd was elected.


It was decided to have a meeting again next fall.
