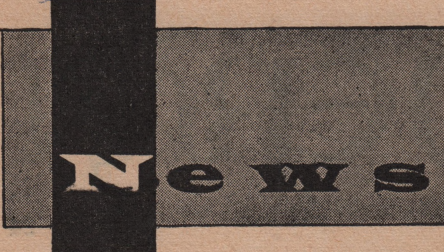
On the last Sunday of Pastor Hansen's stay at St. Paul's, May 29, 55 young people were confirmed. The Sunday before that was also a highlight for the congregation when 140 men went to the mountains for their fourth annual Spiritual Retreat.

Lynwood, Calif.—Pastor Allan D. Hansen has resigned as Pastor of St. Paul's Lutheran. Pastor Hansen said that he never was happier for the way things were progressing in the church than at present but felt that the congregation deserved a change in its ministry. Pastor Hansen has served the congregation since its organization in 1945. The church property is valued at approximately \$500,000 and the church hopes to be debt free in about four years. The congregation holds three Sunday morning services in the new church which was built six years ago. The church also conducts a Christian Day School through the sixth grade with an enrollment of 225. Pastor Hansen has accepted a call from a congregation only five years old located in Garden Grove, California. This congregation has as yet only its first unit. It has 1300 baptized members and it belongs to ELC.
