The deceased, Mrs. Marie Theodora Olsen was born in Denmark, Kansas, on December 29, 1876. She was the daughter of James and Christine Mogensen. She spent her childhood and early womanhood days at home in Kansas. As a young woman she attended the Danish Folk Highschool here at Elk Horn. At this place she met a young man, Carl M. Olsen whom she later married. This took place on July 27th, 1898, in her home community at Denmark, Kansas. To this union seven children were born, ~~six~~^{five} sons and two daughters.

After his ordination, Pastor and Mrs Olsen went to their new field of labor ^{the congregation} at Foy Sippi and Saxeville, Wisconsin. Subsequently held pastorates ^{were in} in the following communities: Hartland, Wisconsin, Denmark, Wisconsin; and Sioux City, Iowa. They moved to Elk Horn because of Pastor Olsen's health in the fall of 1932. Being encouraged by Pastor Anders Hansen, who at that time was pastor at Elk Horn, Mrs Olsen became the first matron of ~~the~~ old people's Home. That was begun ^{in a house} ~~in~~ in the East end of town.

~~A few years ago~~ After the death of her husband in 1934, Mrs Olsen moved to Flint, Michigan, where she lived for 15 years. She arrived at the Salem Old People's Home in June of 1955. A year later, because of ill health, she was transferred to the Invalid Home. Here she was tenderly cared for until her departure from this life. She passed away on Saturday evening, August the 25th, at the age of 79 years, 7 months and 26 days.

Mrs Olsen has been a lifelong member of the Lutheran Church. For 36 years she filled the important place of a minister's wife. Her humble walk by the side of her husband has been an inspiration to many. Those were difficult days in so many ways; but her faith and truth in God never faltered, she was in the true sense of the word "the handmaid of the Lord."

Mrs Olsen is survived by her seven children. Samuel of White Plains, N. Y; Edmund of Flint, Mich; Mrs Vida Lyda of Merrit Island, Florida; Ansel of Fondu Lac, Wisconsin; ^{HILMS} Mrs L. K. Allen of Kenosha, Wisconsin; Carl of Miami, Florida, and Daniel of Whittier, California. ^{In addition} There are also twelve grandchildren and ~~two~~⁵ great grandchildren; ^{and} One brother, Adolph ^{who} Morgensen, is also living in Kansas. ^{Besides those,} ^{there} are many other relatives ^{who} mourn her departure. We honor her memory and may her memory be blessed among us.

Præster. Vi er for Tiden kort paa Præster, og det var derfor opmunrende at der foreligger Ansøgninger fra to Præster i Danmark om mulig Ansættelse i vort Samfund. Begge har været herovre før, den ene er født her som Søn af en af vores tidligere Præster, som rejste til Danmark, og den anden har studeret herovre, saa begge er det engelske Sprog mægtig, og de har gode Anbefalinger. Vi forstaar, at Pastor emer. N. Chr. Petersen, der med sin Hustru er herovre paa Besøg, nok kunde have Lyst til at give sine sidste Aar i sit gamle Samfunds Tjeneste, dersom der var en Gerning som Hjælpepræst for ham at faa. Han er ganske frisk for sin Alder og med sin Hustru og Datter besøgte os i Blair for en Tid siden.

Harlan, Iowa. Immanuels Mgh. fik sin nye Præstebolig, der ligger paa Grand Avenue, højtidelig indviet for en Tid siden af Kredsformand C. M. Videbeck fra Atlantic, der selv i sin Tid var Præst i Harlan. Samtidig afholdtes aabent Hus i den gamle Bolig ved Siden af Kirken paa 7de Street, som er forvandlet til Menighedshus og Søndagsskolelokale.

Elk Horn, Iowa. Pastor Carl M. Olsens Enke, Marie Theodora Olsen, afgik stille ved Døden Lørdag Aften d. 25. August 1956 paa Invalidehjemmet her, meddeler Anstaltens Præst, Pastor Henry N. Hansen. I de sidste Maaneder havde hun været saa syg af Kræft, at hun maatte overføres til denne Afdeling efter at have haft sit Ophold paa Salems Alderdomshjem siden

Juni 1955, hvor hun for godt

en Snæ Aar siden sammen med sin syge Mand var den første Bestyrer. Pastor Olsen døde der d. 19. Aug. 1934 og blev begravet paa Kirkegaarden. Og nu d. 29. August blev hans trofaste Hustru stedt til Hvile ved hans Side efter en Sørgegudstjeneste i Salems Kapel. Pastor Hansen varetog denne og som Ligbærere tjente seks Nabopræster, Clarence Jensen (Elk Horn), M. P. Bolleson (Audubon), Irving Petersen (Jacksonville), Sedoris McCartney (Brayton), Stanley Larsen (Exira) og Victor Staby (Kimballton). Fem af Afdødes syv Børn var tilstede ved Begravelsen og tog Afsked med en trofast og elskelig Moder, hvis Liv og Færd som Præstefrue og Husmoder havde været en Inspiration for mange og hvis Tro paa Guds kærlige Førelse og Sandhedsord aldrig svigtede.

Hun blev født d. 29. Dec. 1876 i et dansk Pionerhjem

i Denmark, Kansas, til Forældrene James og Christine Morgensen og der voksede hun op under meget primitive Forhold. Det Aar, hun blev født, tog Græshopperne Hvedeavlen og de kom igen det næste Aar. Alligevel begyndte de danske Nybyggere at bygge en lille Kalkstenskirke i de Aar, som blev færdig i 1880. Den lille Nybygd bestod kun af 6 Huse og der var Postkontor og en Skole; den nærmeste større By var Salina, ca. 50 Mil borte, hvortil deres Avlinger maatte bringes indtil en Jernbane endelig kom dertil. En dansk Menighed blev organiseret af Pastor O. L. Kirkeberg i 1877 og en Søndagsskole begyndt i 1880, hvor Marie har gaaet og maa-ske ogsaa tjent som Lærerinde. De første Præster var A. Becker og F. M. Christensen (Fader til Pastor A. C. Kildegaard); senere kom Ole Gregersen, R. Ravn, J. L. J. Dixen, C. Hasle og Johs. Jensen. En af Lederne i Menigheden var J. L. Nygaard fra Aarhus Egnen, som havde gaaet paa Hindholm Højskole i Danmark og var vakt til Trosliv gennem Indremissionærerne Jens Larsen og Jens Dyrholm. Jens Morgensens kom fra Sjælland til Kansas i 1870-71 og det er vist en af deres Sønner, Oluf Morgensen, der var den første der fra Koloni-en, som tog Lærerkørsamen og holdt en Tid Menighedsskole i Perth Amboy, N. J. Ogsaa Marie kom paa den danske Højskole i Elk Horn, Ia., og det var her hun mødte sin tilkommende Ægtefælle, den københavnske Snedkersvend, Carl Mettus Olsen, fra Racine, Wis., som i 1892 var kommen til Amerika og var blevet vakt og omvendt ved Pastor H. J. Dahlstrøms Forkyndelse i Emmauskirken. To Aar efter tog han paa Elk Horn Højskole, som da blev købt af „Missionsforeningen“ i Den danske Kirke og blev saa ved „Nordkirken“s Dannelse tillige dette Samfunds Præsteskole. Efter et Aar i Højskolen og to Aar i den teologiske Afdeling, som i Oktober 1896 blev overført med Kirkesamfundet i Den Forenede danske ev. luth. Kirke, var han et Aar paa Trinitatis Seminarium i Blair, Nebr. Den 5. Juni 1898 blev han ordineret under Aarsmødet i Greenville, Mich., og blev saa gift med Marie d. 27. Juli s.A. i hendes Hjem. Deres præstelige Virksomhed begyndte i Poy Sippi-Saxeville, Wis., derefter i Maple Valley-Gillett, Wis., Hartland, Wis., Denmark, Wis. og endte 1932 i Sioux City, Ia., da de paa Grund af Pastor Olsens Helbredstilstand opgav aktiv Præstegerning og flyttede til Elk Horn. I Aarene 1926-32 tjente han Samfundet som Sekretær. Efter sin Mands Død blev Mrs. Olsen nogle Aar i Elk Horn og flyttede saa til Flint, Mich., hvor Sønnen Edmund boede. Alle syv Børn overlever hende; de andre er Samuel i White Plains, N. Y., Ansel i Fond du Lac, Wis., Carl i Miami, Fla., Daniel i Whittier, Calif., Mrs. Vida Leyda i Mirrit Island, Fla., og Mrs. Hilma Allen Kenosha, Wis. Ogsaa tolv Børnebørn og fem i næste Slægtled, samt en Broder, Adolph Morgen-son i Kansas, overlever hende. Hun var i Sandhed en Herrens Tjenerinde. Velsignet være hendes Minde!
