**FRANK B. LINDEN
DIED HERE SUNDAY**

Frank B. Linden, well known Washington County farmer and a resident of the county for nearly a century, died at Memorial Community Hospital at Blair Sunday. He was 91 years old.

Mr. Linden was born in this county October 15th, 1876 to Mr. and Mrs. John Jacob Linden. His entire life was spent in this area and he was one of the elder citizens of the county. He was a carpenter for many years before returning to the farm. As a younger man he took an active interest in community affairs.

On June 23, 1907 he was married to Martha Von Lanken.

Mrs. Linden died a number of years ago but he is survived by a son and a daughter, both of whom

live in the Blair area. Also one grandson and two great grandchildren.

The daughter is Mrs. S. Walter Andersen (Margaret) of 2154 Lincoln Street, Blair. The son is George Bert Bertrand, who operates the home farm west of Blair.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, April 10th at the Campbell Mortuary with the Rev. George Pallesen conducting the service. Burial was in the Blair Cemetery.
