**PREPARATORY SEMINARY COURSE.**

This course is intended primarily to fit young men for the Seminary.

Young men wishing admittance to the first year in this course, are required to take examination or submit satis-

### EXPENSES.

The school year comprises 35 weeks. The total expenses of a student for tuition, board, heat, light, and room is \$4.00 per week or \$16.00 per month of four weeks, payable in advance. A reduction is given students paying full rates and attending the whole year. The total expense for the whole year is \$140.00. From this sum the reduction of \$10.00 is made, provided the rules for advance payments are complied with. To this should be added the cost of washing and also the cost of books, stationery, etc. Students paying for tuition only are charged \$40.00 for the year.

#### REBATE OF TRANSPORTATION.

Students living more than 200 miles from Blair, and remaining at least 16 weeks, will be entitled to a rebate of one half the distance over and above 200 miles, coming to school. Take receipt from station agent, stating distance and amount paid.

The former plan of furnishing bedding to students has been discontinued, and in the future students will be required to supply themselves with the necessary bed clothing. This change has not been made from pecuniary motives, but is a much needed sanitary regulation that every cleanly student must approve of. Such clean bedding as we have on hand will be available for free distribution among such students as may wish to use it.
