Library Tops 60,000 Mark



Miss Nielsen presents record-breaking volumes to Librarian.

Mr. Ron Johnson, head librarian, has announced that the total number of volumes in the Dana Library has topped the 60,000 mark.

The new figure was reached with a gift from Miss Luella Nielsen, Associate Professor of English.

Miss Nielsen presented the Library with 35 volumes of *Horizon*, a quarterly humanities publication. She is a charter member of the *Horizon* series and has the entire set dating back to the first issue published in 1958. The 35 volumes presented to the Library completes the College's collection of *Horizon*.

Mr. Johnson reported that a significantly large number of volumes has been added to the Library this year through a campaign for funds among Dana's alumni. Individual gifts, such as that by Miss Nielsen, have also helped reach the current figure.

The 60 thousand volumes now on hand will be moved to the new Library building later this year.

Parents' Day --- April 27th

This year's annual Parents' Day at Dana has been scheduled for April 27.

Events for the day have been planned by the Dana Parents Committee under the direction of the chairmen, Mr. and Mrs. Beck Kaldahl of Omaha.

As in the past, all parents of past and present Dana students—and parents whose high school children are considering Dana as their college—are invited to attend.

Mr. Kaldahl emphasized, "Parents of prospective students should definitely bring their children with them on Parents' Day so they can get a better idea of what Dana has to offer."

The day will begin with Worship Service in Borup Coliseum at 10:30 a.m. followed by dinner in the Main Dining Room of the Campus Center.

At 1:30 p.m., a presentation entitled "Dana Today" will be given by President C. C. Madsen and representatives of the faculty and student body.

At 2:30, two simultaneous discussion groups will give parents an opportunity to learn about and discuss the out-of-class life of their sons and daughters.

Other events in the afternoon include the traditional President's Reception, Campus Open House, Campus

Tours, and a special session dealing with facts and figures for prospective students and their parents.

The day will be climaxed by the Dana Choir and Band's presentation of "What Is Man?" The program will be over by 8:00 p.m. so visitors can get an early start for home.

A detailed schedule of events and a reservation form will be sent to all parents by April 14. If you wish to attend Parents' Day and have not received your reservation form by that date, please contact the Development Office since advance reservations are required.

Simon Being "Sworn In"

Mr. Simon, who resides with his wife and two children at Troy, Ill., served 14 years in the Illinois Legislature before being elected lieutenant governor last November.

He became the first person in the state's history to be elected lieutenant governor with a governor of another political party. (Lt. Gov. Simon is a Democrat and Governor Richard Ogilvie is a Republican.)

Mr. Simon received an honorary Doctor of Laws degree from Dana in 1966.
