Year-End Ceremonies Are Scheduled For Sunday, May 31

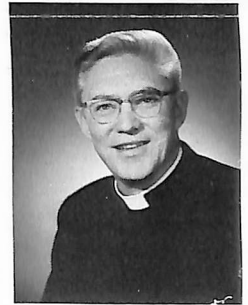
Year-end ceremonies at Dana, including the traditional Baccalaureate Service and the Conferring of Degrees Ceremony, will be held in Borup Coliseum on Sunday, May 31. Both services will be open to the general public.

The Baccalaureate Service, scheduled for 10:30 a.m., will be conducted by the Reverend Elwin Bergstraesser, campus pastor. The Reverend Archie Madsen, President of the Central District of The American Lutheran Church Council, will be the guest speaker.

A total of 188 seniors, the largest graduating class in Dana's history, will be presented as degree candidates during the 2:00 p.m. Degree Conferring Ceremony. Following a pattern set last year, no formal guest speaker will appear on the afternoon program. Presi-

dent C. C. Madsen will, however, deliver brief remarks to the graduates and guests.

An honorary degree and several awards for distinguished service are also scheduled for presentation during the Sunday afternoon ceremony. The Reverend Archie Madsen, recently elected Pres-

ident of the Central District, has been selected by the Dana faculty to receive an honorary Doctor of Divinity degree. The 1970 College-Community Service Award will be presented to an outstanding Blair resident whose identity is not announced until the actual presentation. Special recognition will be given to an outstanding layman of the Central District, Mr. Dale Bruning of Bruning, Nebraska. Bruning is slated to receive Dana's 1970 Distinguished Service Award.

Annual Blair Appeal Tops 1970 Goal

Dana's 1970 appeal for financial support from the Blair community was conducted early in April by the Development Office staff and some sixty volunteer workers from Blair. The one-day campaign surpassed its 1970 goal of \$10,000 as indicated on a giant thermometer on display in downtown Blair.

Director of Development Carter Reynolds reported that an excess of \$13,000 has now been realized from the Blair community. He pointed out that the total figure represents an approximate per capita gift of \$2.00 and compared it to a similar campaign recently conducted in Fremont, Nebraska, by Midland College which resulted in a \$1.50 per capita gift. According to Reynolds, "Blair really came through with significantly strong support of Dana."

Two Dana Alums Elected To Council

Two members of the Alumni Association have been elected to the Advisory Council as a result of the mail ballot carried in the March issue of the REVIEW.
