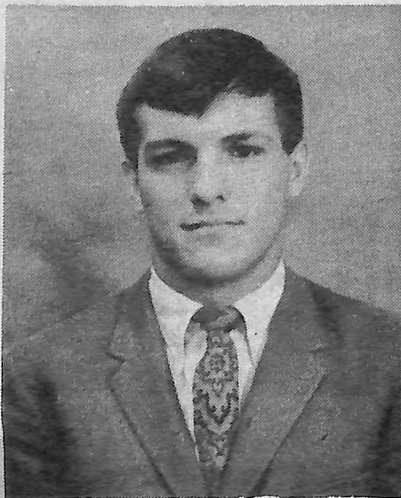


King Steve

Tonight the Cle-Shays will be playing for the Mayfest Dance. The price is \$1.00 per single, \$1.50 for couples.

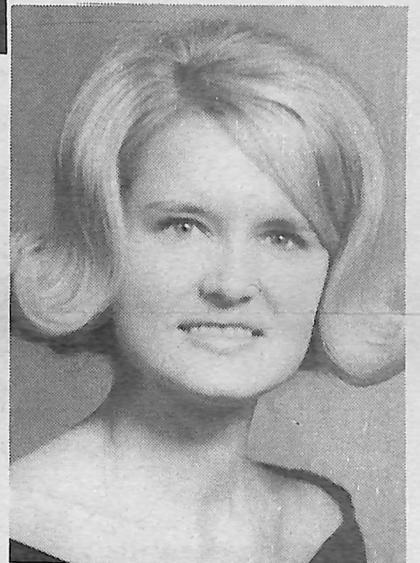
Karen Nelson

Vietnamese Ambassador Will Speak On Campus



Tran Van Dinh, former acting ambassador from South Vietnam to the United States, will be speaking at Dana on Friday, May 10 at 8:00 p.m.

Dinh is on a nation-wide speaking tour sponsored by the Methodist Board of Christian Social Concerns. He previously spoke in Omaha to an Ad-Sell League dinner in January, 1967.

Mr. Dinh, born in Hue, was active in the anti-Japanese underground, and in the Vietnam Independence War against the French. He joined the South Vietnamese Foreign Service in 1954; his last post was Acting Ambassador to the United States. He resigned in 1964 to become a journalist, writer and lecturer.

He has contributed articles to The Christian Science Monitor, The New Republic, Commonweal, The Nation, War/Peace Report, New Politics, The Washingtonian, and The Christian Century. He

has published a book on the war in Vietnam titled No Passenger on the River.

Mr. Dinh is a regular columnist for the U.S. Collegiate Press Service. Mr. Dinh's name appears in Who's Who in Asia, and he has lectured in nearly 200 universities and colleges in the United States. He recently appeared on NBS's, "Vietnam and After: What Should We Do?", on February 11, 3-4:30 p.m. in a discussion with Senators Douglas and McGee, Ambassador Reischauer and Kenneth Galbraith and Richard Barnett.
