Cosmopolitan,	Scandinaven.



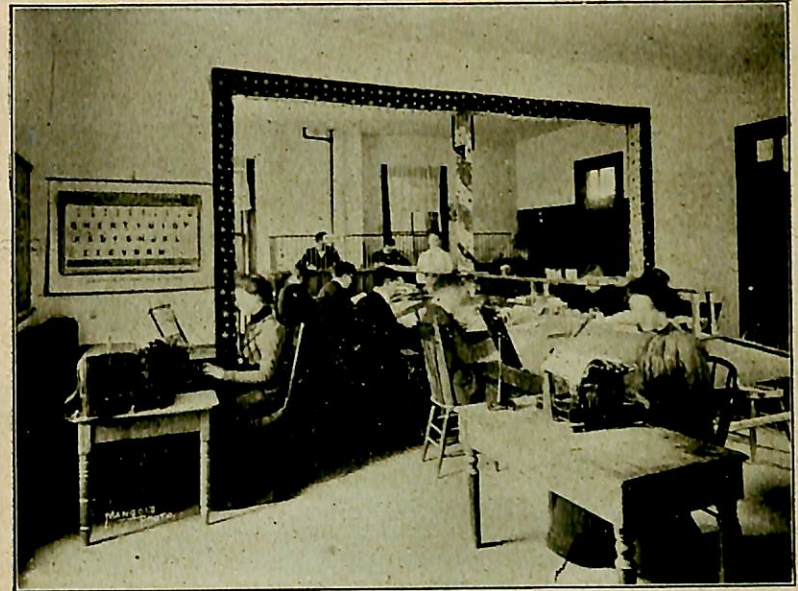
### Out-of-Door Sports.

Our Commercial Department is thorough and practical. In the celebrated Ellis System of Actual Business each student starts a business of his own under the individual supervision of competent instructors.

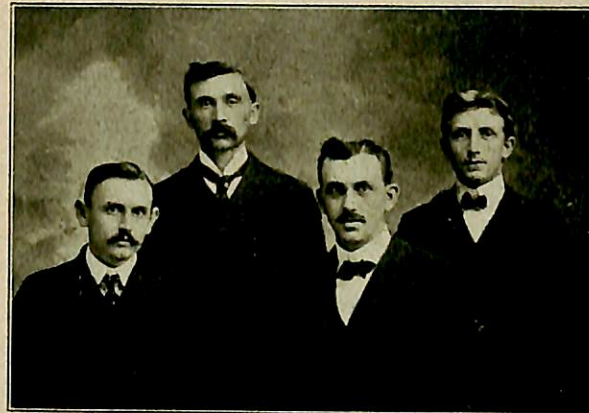
The Pitmanic Systems of Shorthand are taught. Remington typewriters are used.


