


## A Place Called DANA

The seventeen mile drive from the north edge of Omaha to Blair, Nebraska takes one through an unusual panorama of beauty; well wooded hills, rolling valleys, the broad Missouri river and the distant bluffs of Iowa on the horizon. This was the place chosen in 1884 by Danish pioneers as the location for an educational institution of the Church - a place called Dana.

The pioneer founders were primarily concerned with the task of training young men for the parish ministry and, as a result, the roots of Dana College are in the Church. As broader educational needs emerged, Dana was founded as a separate College of liberal arts in 1889.

For many years Dana and Trinity operated as a two-fold institution of the United Evangelical Lutheran Church sharing the same campus in Blair. In 1960, however, the UELC joined hands with two other Lutheran bodies to form the new The American Lutheran Church. Trinity Seminary moved to the campus of Wartburg Seminary in Dubuque, Iowa and Dana remained in Blair as one of eleven senior colleges of the newly formed Church.

The campus itself is located on a hilltop just west of the city of Blair and covers more than 180 acres. Since 1960 the enrollment has more than doubled and five new buildings have been added to the physical campus. A continuing program of expansion and improvement is currently in progress.

Dana is fully accredited by the North Central Association and the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education and credits earned here are recognized at colleges and universities throughout the United States. Students may choose from sixteen major fields of study plus a variety of pre-professional and preparatory courses leading to the Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree.


Because the need of every generation is intelligent men and women of dynamic Christian faith and character, Dana holds to the conviction that the Christian way of life is essential to the complete development of human personality and strives to develop this philosophy within her students.



Pioneer Memorial, Library-Administration Building, was completed in 1948 and named in honor of the pioneer founders.



Two spacious library reading rooms are housed in Pioneer Memorial plus well over 30,000 volumes of reference works and innumerable periodicals. One of the largest collections of Danish literature in English translation found in the United States is also housed here.






Most dormitory rooms are designed for occupancy by two students providing a maximum opportunity for study, relaxation and comfort.



Argo Hall, Elk Horn, Mickelsen, Holling, Omaha Village and the Units, all provide comfortable living quarters for campus residents. The well furnished rooms, spacious lounges, modern facilities for laundry, study rooms and recreational facilities combine to make dormitory living a most enjoyable and interesting part of college life.

The main lounge of Holling Hall, residence for men, is a popular place for recreational reading, informal conversation and entertainment of guests.






Athletics, physical education and recreation play an important part in life at Dana. The new Borup Coliseum offers a wide variety of activities ranging from inter-collegiate athletics to intramurals and physical fitness classes to recreational swimming. The regulation AAU indoor swimming pool was made possi-

ble through the efforts of Dana students who raised one-hundred thousand dollars for its construction.

Dana is a member of the Tri-State Conference and competes in a full schedule of inter-collegiate athletics including football, basketball, track, baseball, tennis and golf.






carried out during the next five year period. Currently under construction is a new men's residence hall and a campus center.


The future is bright at this place called Dana but the challenges it brings will demand the continued dedication of her students, faculty and administration.










## Meaning of Unity in Chaos

In an upperclassman initiation prompts aloofness of unconcern, thankfulness for immunity, hints of nostalgia, memories of laughter and forgotten plans.


