



And they triumphed...*





The goal of year-long toil*



Ken Lizer and his committee spent many months planning our Homecoming—to them we offer congratulations for a job well-done.




The homecoming dinner was a Danish Smorgasbord served in the cafeteria. Tables were decorated with miniature flower arrangements holding a Danish and an American flag.
