
Dana joined the many colleges and universities across the United States in the Viet Nam War Moratorium on October 15, 1969.


Homecoming 1969




Passing the president's home on his way back to the dorm from an evening of study at the library, Pastor Jensen sang "I Wonder What C.C. is Doing Tonight."



Orient Choir Tour






The choir had the opportunity to sing in large, elaborate concert halls. At this concert in Kobe, Japan, the choir had the opportunity to meet the oldest Dana alumni, Dr. Winther, a 91-year-old missionary to Japan.

Uniformly dressed in red, white, and blue, the 50 voice choir left San Francisco on the first Orient Tour in the history of Dana College Choir. They performed for audiences ranging in size from 50 to 8,000. At one time they sang for some 13 million people over the Japanese television network. The tour was entirely self-supporting with the individual students paying most of the cost, the remainder being paid by concerts. The tour took the choir to Japan, Okinawa, Hong Kong, Taipei, Manila, and Hawaii. The choir members agree that it is an experience they will never forget.


The Vikings ended with a 4-3 wrestling record. It is the first time in Dana's history that the grapplers have finished above a 50-50 record.








Baseball—Spring 1969

"Not bad, if I do say so myself!" boasts captain Ron Bernier.




