












Activities

He constantly ran errands for us, going out of his way so we got what we needed. All these things add up to show a very deep love he had for all of us.


At this particularly sad time we can find a happy note in the fact that he lived a true faith in God.

The 1971 football season was indeed a season of changes. Bob Simpson, in his first season as head coach at Dana, gave the school its first successful season since 1962. After a slow start, Dana sparked up and showed a tough driving spirit. Dana's grudging defense, which finally won the respect it deserved, showed opponents it had not lost any of its stonewall disposition.

Dana's offense had a shaky start, showing inexperience in some areas at the beginning of the year. Then, towards midseason, the Vikings metamorphosised into a winning combination and won five of their last seven games.

Throughout the season Dana's fine defense proved to be an invaluable asset, especially for the several rainy games, giving Dana the winning edge.

Dana showed some of its Norse heritage by terrorizing its last three opponents. The defense and offense worked together like a well-oiled machine, shutting out Midland 19-0 during Homecoming and Sioux Falls 14-0 the following week.


Dana took on the spoiler role in the final game of the season by beating a heavily-favored and nationally-ranked Doane College team 24-14.















Dana's consistently good baseball team completed another successful season last spring with an overall record of 22 wins and 13 losses. Coach Dale Lemon's team won the NIAC Conference for the second consecutive year with a 9 and 1 record. In the Tri-State Conference Dana placed second with an 8 and 4 record to 9 and 3 Westmar. For the third straight year, Dana's baseball team competed in the NAIA District 11 playoffs, its fourth time in six years.

During the tour of Oklahoma and Kansas over Easter vacation, the baseball team won seven and lost four.



This was a ray of light. You start out by hoping, and you fee that hope a batch of God's word, especially His promises to a believer. Then while you're waiting for something to happen, as you continue to hope, God has opportunity to turn that hope into FAITH! Later, I discovered that the author of the book of Hebrews had said it even better. "Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the convictions of things not seen." (Hebrews 11: 1)."

For in this hope we were saved, Now hope that is seen is not hope, For who hopes for what he sees? But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience. (Romans 8: 24,25)

Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through Him we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in our hope of sharing the glory of God. More than that, we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit which has been given to us. (Romans 5: 1-5)



Through the centuries men have displayed many different symbols to show that they are Christians. They have worn marks in the lapels of their coats, hung chains about their necks, even had special haircuts.

Of course, there is nothing wrong with any of this, if one feels it is his calling. But there is a much better sign—a mark that has not been thought up just as a matter of expediency for use on some special occasion or in some specific era. It is a universal mark that is to last through all the ages of the church 'til Jesus comes back.

What is this mark?

At the close of His ministry, Jesus looks forward to His death on the cross, the open tomb and the ascension. Knowing that He is about to leave, Jesus prepares His disciples for what is to come. It is here that He makes clear what will be the distinguishing mark of the Christian:

Little children, yet a little while I am with you. You will seek me; and as I said to the Jews so now I say to you, 'Where I am going you cannot come.' A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another. (John 13:33-35)

Francis Schaeffer THE MARK OF THE CHRISTIAN

If I had the gift of being able to speak in other languages without learning them, and could speak in every language there is in all of heaven and earth, but didn't love others, I would only be making noise. If I had the gift of prophecy and knew all about what is going to happen in the future, knew everything about EVERYTHING, but didn't love others, what good would it do? Even if I had the gift of faith so that I could speak to to a mountain and make it move, I would still be worth nothing at all without love. If I gave everything I have to poor people, and if I were burned alive for preaching the Gospel but didn't love others, it would be of no value whatever.

Love is very patient and kind, never jealous or envious, never boastful or proud, never haughty or selfish or rude. Love does not demand its own way. It is not irritable or touchy. It does not hold grudges and will hardly even notice when others do it wrong. It is never glad about injustice, but rejoices whenever truth wins out. If you love someone you will be loyal to him no matter what the cost. You will always believe him, always expect the best of him, always stand your ground in defending him.

(I Cor. 13:1-7) LIVING BIBLE



The eye cannot say to the hand, 'I have no need of you.' or again the head to the feet, 'I have no need of you.' On the contrary, the parts of the body which seem to be weaker are indispensable, and those parts of the body which we think less honorable we invest with the greater honor, and our unpresentable parts are treated with greater modesty, which our more presentable parts do not require. But God has so adjusted the body, giving the greater honor to the inferior part, that there may be no discord in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another. If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together.

Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it."
(I Cor. 12: 14-27)
