Halloween seems to bring the beast out in some Dana people. The Halloween supper looks like SAGA didn't have to go to any special dishes to feed the witches and ghosts.



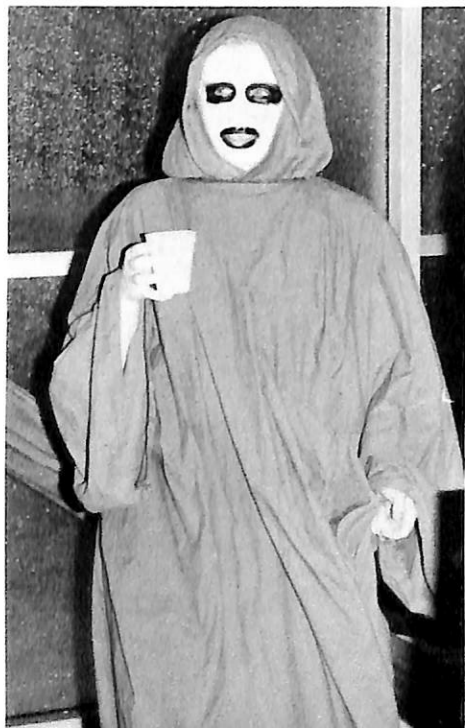

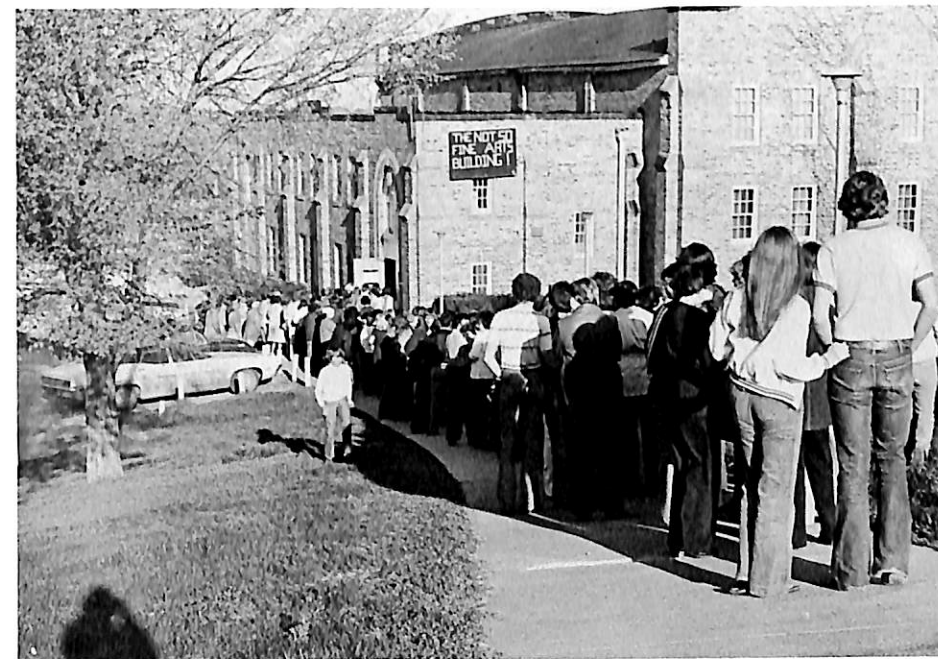

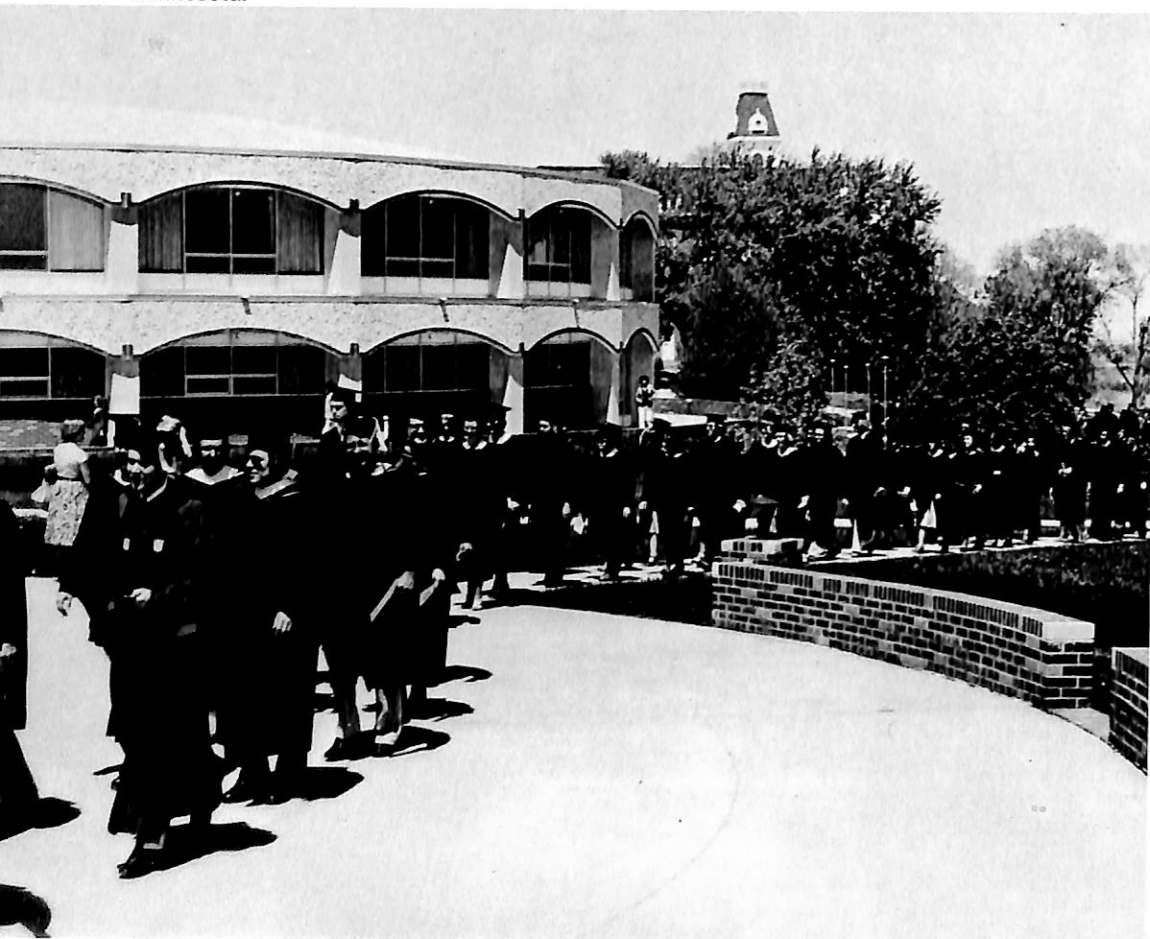




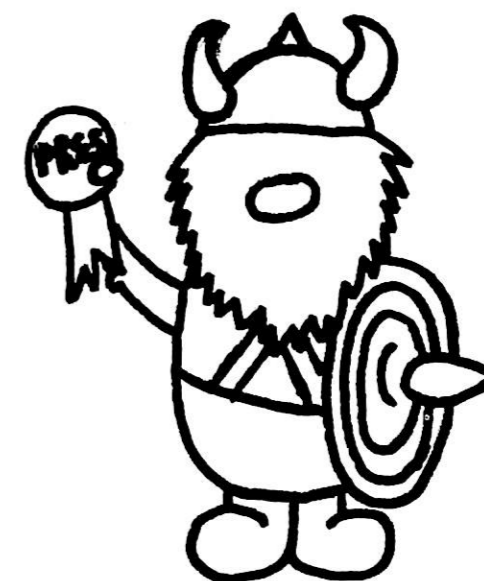
# Graduation

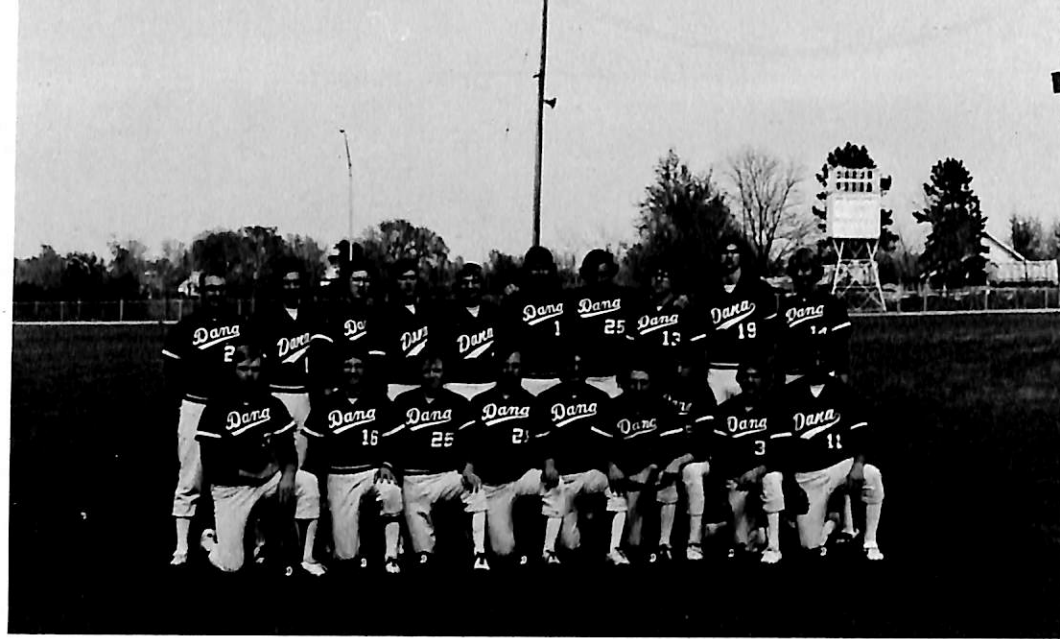




## Wrestling 1977-1978

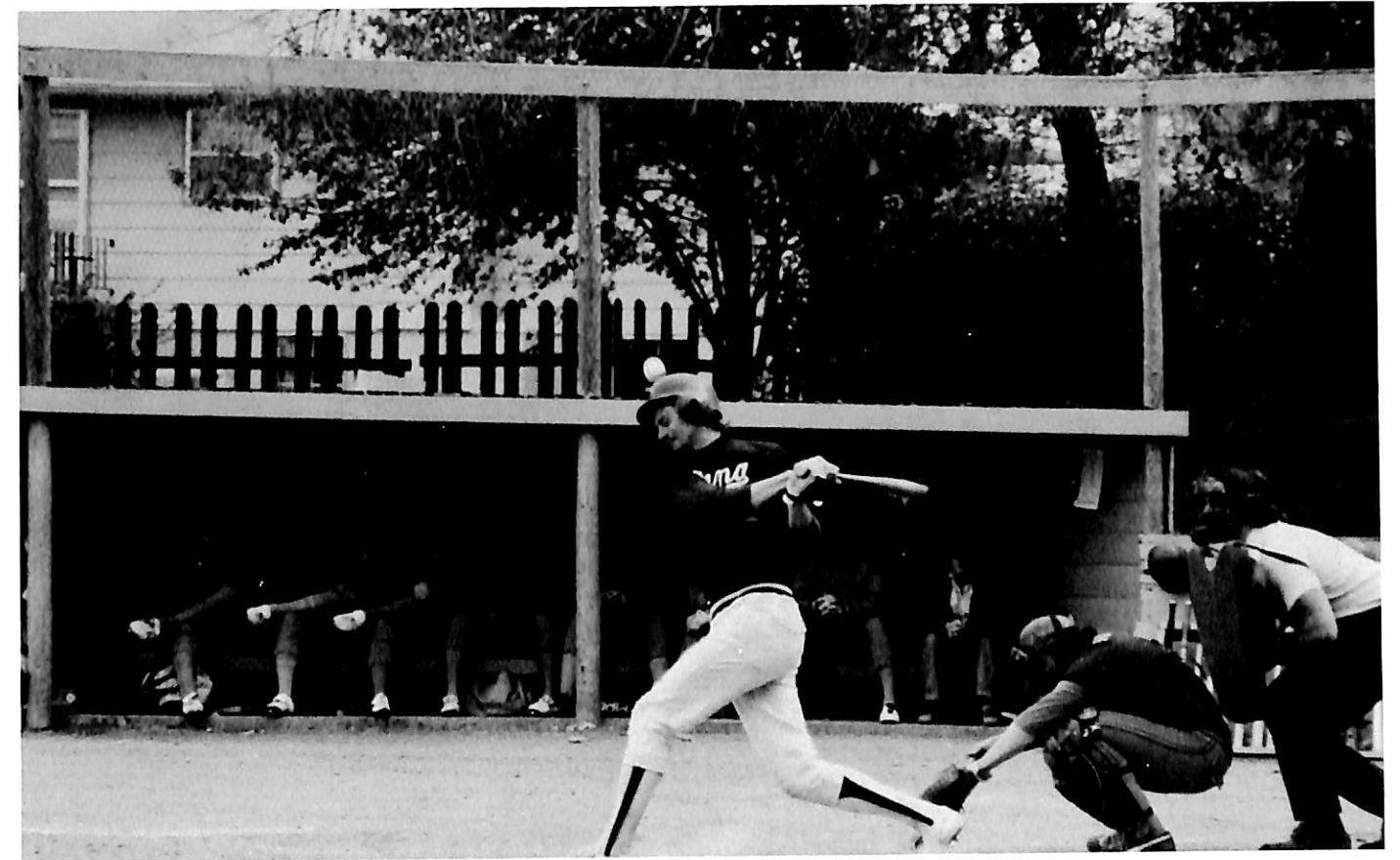
