Valedictorian Mary Asmus




Sixty-five seniors received Bachelor degrees at the Commencement ceremony on May 17, 1981, twenty-five with honors. The Valedictorian was Mary Asmus, and Brian Serr and Laura Anderson were Salutatorians.

The Baccalaureate service was held at 10 a.m. with the Reverend Dr. Paul Jersild as main speaker. Jersild, who is the Dean of Wartburg Theological Seminary in Dubuque, Iowa, spoke of the scandal of Christian vocation. Education brings with it power, and this power should be used for service.

The Commencement program included a community service award to Kenneth Rhodes, editor of the Blair newspapers, and the conferring of three honorary degrees. Jersild received one, as well as Walther Prausnitz and Roald Kindem. Prausnitz is the Director of Liberal Arts Studies at Concordia College in Minnesota. Kindem is the Director of the Office of Communication and Mission Support for the American Lutheran Church. He gave the Commencement address and spoke of three words for the eighties: communication, compassion, and commitment. The program closed with the traditional "Hail Dana."



The Vikings ended the 1980-81 basketball season with 11 wins and 17 losses. The conference record was 3 and 6 for fifth place. Dana shot 47% from the field, while their opponents hit 50.9%.

Three seniors will graduate, Brian Serr, Larry Fry, and Scott Simms. Serr was top scorer, averaging 17.8 points per game with a total of 1340 points in his 4-year career. He was selected to the NAIC all-conference second team. Fry averaged 8.9 per game while Simms had a 14.5 point average. 


