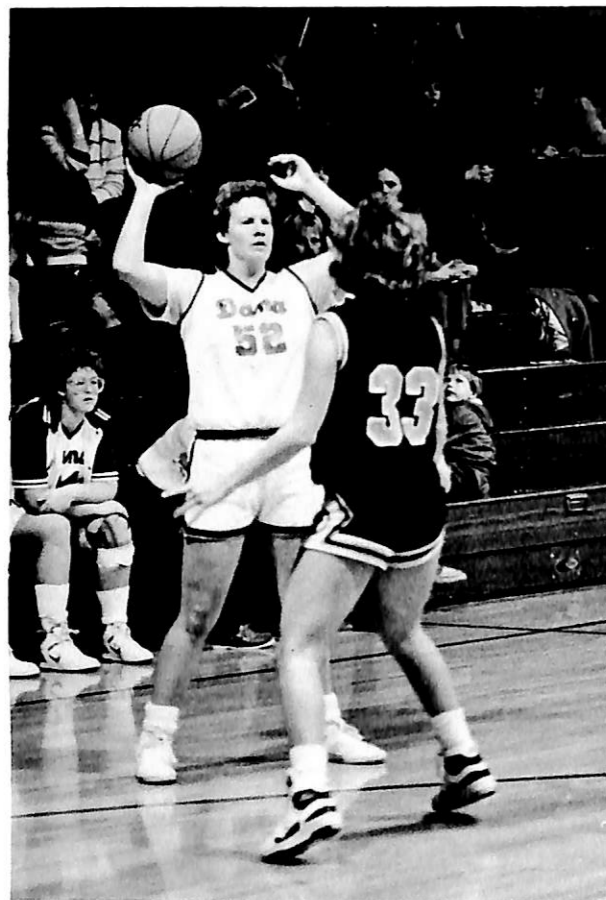


Basketball

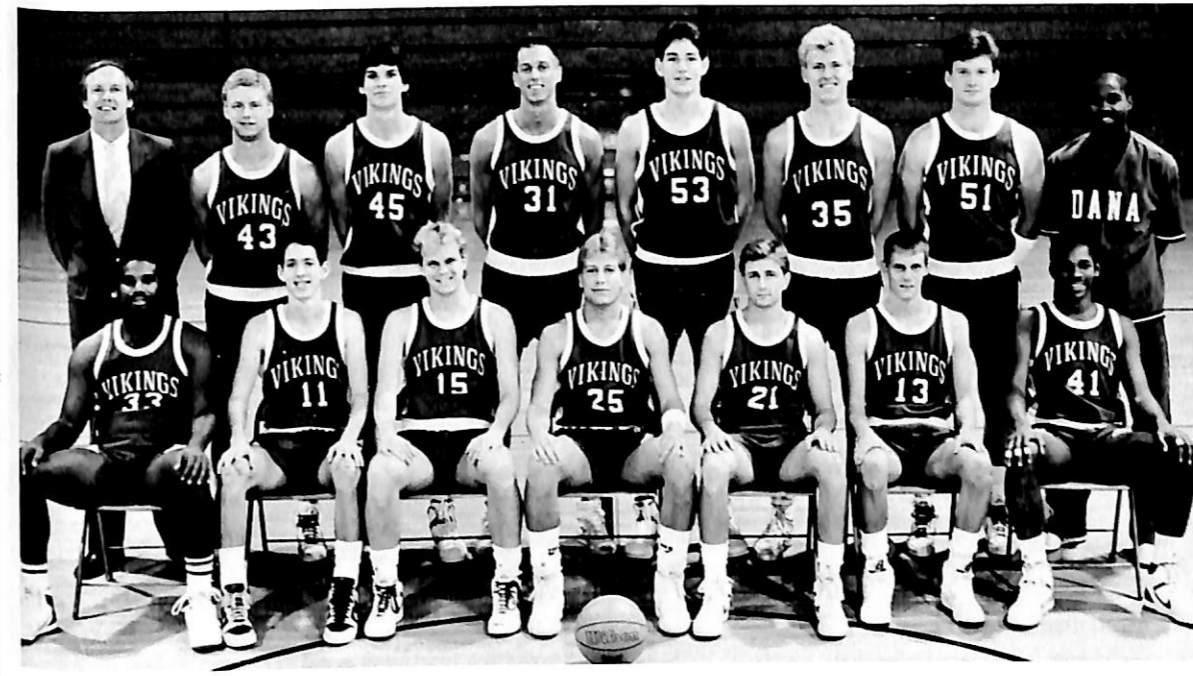


Lisa Mayr scored the most points in the season with a total of 383.

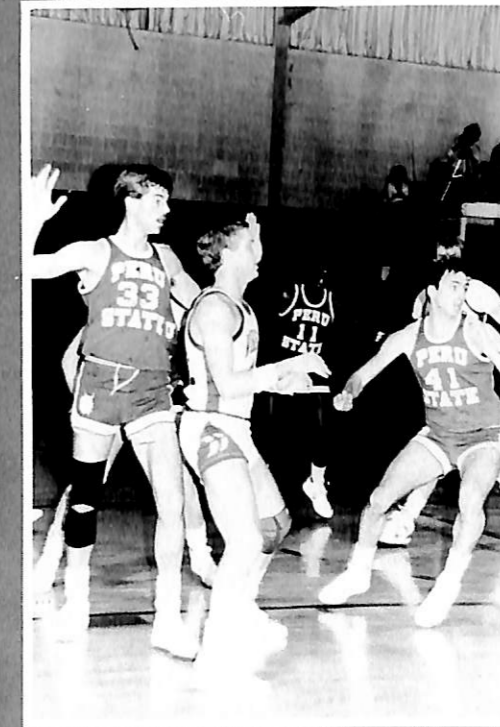


Amy Nissen takes a shot in the Doane game.
