ARCHIVE/MUSEUM COOPERATION: As an indication of the good relations that exist between the Archive at Dana and the Museum in Elk Horn is the fact that Dana is transferring the chancel furnishings from Nazareth Lutheran, Beresford, South Dakota to the museum. These are the furnishings that were on exhibit in Odense, Denmark during 1997 and 1998. Because they are seldom used at Dana it is felt that many more people will benefit from seeing them if they are on display in Elk Horn. This transfer will make possible the installation of the shelving that has arrived to hold the Danish Brotherhood and Sisterhood material.

<u>DANISH CONSULS VISIT DANA</u>: Nine honorary Danish Consuls representing Michigan, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, North and South Dakota, Iowa, Kansas, Missouri and Texas visited the Dana campus in July. This was a good opportunity to acquaint them with the Archive and Lur Publications.

<u>CONGRATULATIONS</u>: Our congratulations to volunteer Joan Sorensen who is being married to Roland Jensen in early September. Both will be among the October volunteers.

<u>LUR PUBLICATIONS</u>: Norman C. Bansen's <u>Passages from India</u> was released in late July and Martha Loeffler's <u>Boats in the Night</u> will be released mid-September. The former consists of letters, essays and poems from the China-Burma-India Theater of WW II, and the latter is an account of Knud Dyby's role in the Danish resistance and the rescue of the Danish Jews during the same war. Bansen's book sells for \$19.95; Loeffler's for \$14.95. POstage is \$3.50 for the first book purchased and \$1.00 for each additional one. Nebraska residents must add 6% tax.
