Saturday's presentations were on the theology of the UELC by Paul Jersild, the role of the archive in preserving a heritage by John W. Nielsen, and the expectations and perspective of women by John Mark and Dawn Nielsen. Sunday's worship used the hymns and liturgy of the blue Hymnal for Church and Home with Norman. Freund as liturgist and Roland Hansen as preacher. An offering of more than \$1200.00 was divided between Dana College and the Oaks Indian Center, two institutions supported by the UELC. Since it probably isn't, steps must be taken now to assure the continuation of archival operations even after I am no longer able to put in from twenty-five to forty hours a week of volunteer time. To address that issue, a preservation fund or endowment must be established. Timothy and Sharon Jensen have launched this fund with a \$1000.00 gift. From time to time accumulated funds over and above operating expenses will be transferred into the fund. Additional contributions will be needed to reach an initial goal of \$100,000.00. Can it be done? Of course it can.
