I do, however, want to mention four items in particular. Homer Nielsen has given the archive the letter from Kleinchen Melchior which marked the beginning of Laurits Melchior's long and significant connection with Dana College. Paul Hansen, besides donating a vast collection of sermons preached by his father, Donal T. Hansen, and his grandfather, Henry N. Hansen, presented us with a sailor's log kept by his great, great grandfather when he sailed around the world on the Danish ship Galatea from 1845-1847. Vicki Madsen has presented us with pictures and 29 love letters exchanged by Jens and Olga Sahl. The final gift is an extensive collection of material from the Danish Sisterhood Lodge of Lexington, NE with an accompanying translation of the Danish items by Dorthea Jessen Yeutter.
