EXPLANATION: To those of you who are on our personal Christmas list and to all of you who have sent financial and material gifts to the Archive during the past two months, the reason that you have not received a Christmas letter and/or thank you note is that on Thanksgiving Day I fell victim to the debilitating viral influenza that has swept the nation. My only recollection of the illness itself is violent chills and very high fever. It resulted in my physical strength being completely depleted and my mental and emotional energies ravished. Only since mid-January have I begun to regain a semblance of the old self. So at this late date, I send you all a Christmas greeting and a wish for a good 2004. The Christmas message that I began read, "And so....in spite of everything....the Christ Child comes!" That, after all, is at the heart of my faith. To all of you who have given generous financial gifts and wonderful and exciting material contributions to the Archive, please accept my sincere "thank you." Without you we could not exist.

LUR BOOK: The most recent Lur book appeared just before Christmas. It is Peter S. Petersen's Memoirs. The cover price is \$27.50, but Archive supporters can buy the book for \$20.00, plus \$2.00 shipping. These memoirs are especially valuable for their depiction of life in the Nebraska and Wyoming of the 1870s and 1880s. Not only do they recall the now almost expected references to blizzards, prairie fires, droughts, and grasshopper infestations, but they describe the founding of villages, churches, and schools as well as Petersen's experiences as a young employee on various farms and in different businesses. Description of railroad work on the Union Pacific and ranching in Wyoming are less common accounts. The Memoirs conclude with his marriage, for that event, as he acknowledges, marks a new stage in his long life. Family members and persons with a connection to Dannebrog and Nysted, Nebraska will find dimensions of interest that may well elude others.

BODTKER RESEARCHER: During several days in mid-January, Anders Rasmussen, one of the two Bodtker Grant recipients for 2004, has been doing research in the Danish Immigrant Archive at Dana. His topic involves Danes who fought in the American Civil War. The nature of his topic has taken him to the National Archives, the universities of Texas and Wisconsin, the Nebraska Historical Society, Vesterheim in Decorah, IA, Grand View in Des Moines, THe Danish Immigrant Museum, and other sites. It is surprising how much secondary material we have in our archive.

HISTORY COURSE: Dr. Iain Anderson, chairman of the history department, at Dana College, is offering a capstone course in historical research for history majors. This means that this second semester seven Dana students will be intensively involved in doing research in the archive.

ARCHIVE LOSS: The Archive lost another faithful supporter with the death of Lilly Jorgensen Sorensen the end of November. Lilly and Sev have been generous supporters and they have given us the Jorgensen (and Sorensen) materials that comprise our second largest collection. Like the Hansen-Mengers Collection it includes thousands of family


