U. STUDENT USES ARCHIVE: Johan Windmuller, an admissions counsellor at Dana, who is wotking on an advanced degree at The University of Nebraska/ Omaha, wrote one of his graduate papers on Paulus Falck using the Falck Collection in the Danish Immigrant Archive. Paulus Falck attended both the Elk Horn Folk High School and Dana College. Following service in World War I, Falck taught at Dana for several years. Windmuller came to the United States as a student from Denmark, first enrolling in an Iowa college but then transferring to Dana. After graduation he worked in law enforcement in Fremont, Nebraska, before assuming his present position at Dana. He has deposited a copy of his paper in the archive.

AABERG AND PAULSEN: Of the 454 hymns in The Hymnal for Church and Home published jointly by the AELC and the UELC, over one-third (169) were translations of Danish hymns. Of that number J.C. Aaberg((AELC) translated 62 and P.C. Paulsen (UELC) translated 60. Among the Aaberg translations are "A Babe Is Born in Bethlehem," "Splendid Are the Heavens High," :Our Father Has Light in His Window," "Behold the Mighty White Robed Band," and "This Is the Day Which the Lord Hath Us Given." Paulsen translations include "I Saw Him in Childhood," "There Is a Way," "How Gladly I My Place Have Taken," "The Country Lies in Deep Repose," and "Thy Blessings Fill Our Earthly Need." It is interesting that in January both men have come to the fore at the Danish Immigrant Archive. Betty Beck Hansen

of Harmony, Minnesota, contacted the archive for information on Paulsen who confirmed her in Chicago, and Walter Yhomsen of Plymouth, Minnesota, the grandson of Aaberg, provided biographical information on his grandfather with prospects of more material to come. Thomsen will be visiting the archive later this spring. J.C. Aaberg's brother Niels was a pastor in the UELC from 1906-1916. Some future scholar may well do a study of the translating styles of Aaberg and Paulsen.
